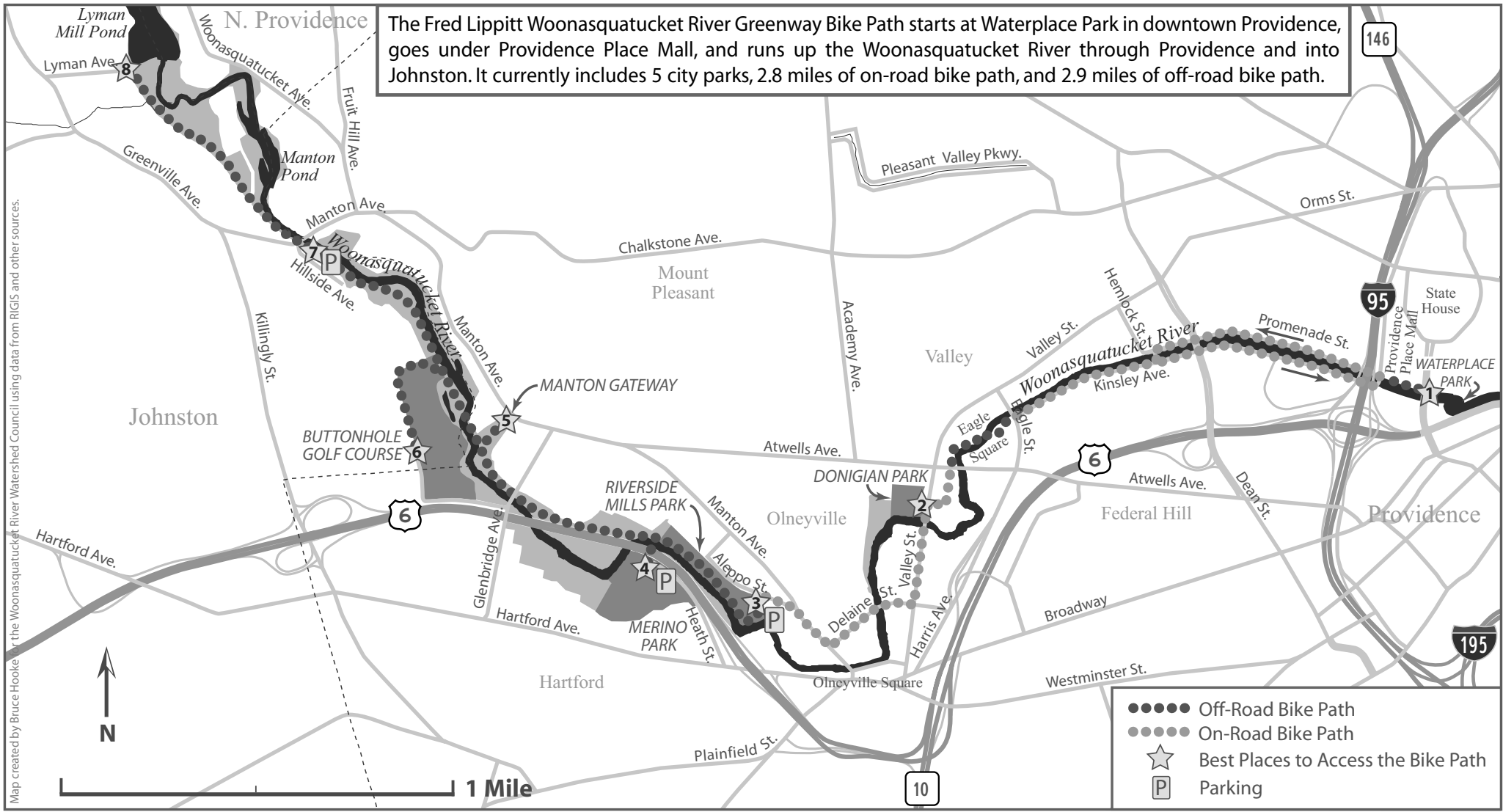


FRED LIPPITT WOONASQUATUCKET RIVER GREENWAY



PLACES TO ACCESS THE BIKE PATH & GREENWAY:

- ★ **1 Waterplace Park** is in downtown Providence, just down the hill from the State House, next to Providence Place Mall. To pick up the bike path, follow the river under the mall. If you are driving here, you can either pay to park at the mall or look for on street parking.
- ★ **2 Donigian Park** is a city park with a playground, a basketball court, a baseball diamond, and a canoe launch. It is in the Valley neighborhood, near the intersection of Atwells and Valley Street. The bike path passes the park on Valley Street. There is usually plenty of on-street parking here.
- ★ **3 Riverside Mills Park** is a new city park with a playground, a canoe launch, and a community garden. It is on Aleppo Street in the Olneyville neighborhood of Providence. The major off-road section of the bike path starts here. There is a small parking lot for the park and bike path.

- ★ **4 Merino Park** is a city park with a playground, a basketball court, and soccer fields. It is in the Hartford neighborhood, just off Route 6. To access the bike path go across the foot bridge over the highway. There is a large parking lot at Merino Park.
- ★ **5 Manton Gateway** is a small green space on Manton Avenue. There is access to the bike path here. The only parking available is on street.
- ★ **6 Buttonhole** is a 9-hole golf course and teaching center run as a non-profit initiative governed by The Golf Foundation of RI. There is a spur to the bike path that wraps around the golf course.
- ★ At **Hillside Avenue**, just off Greenville Avenue in Johnston, there is a small parking lot for the bike path. This is a great place to park to explore the bike path in Johnston.
- ★ The bike path currently ends at **Lyman Avenue** in Johnston. As this is a small residential street, it is better not to park here.
